General Information

Junk

As part of our curriculum we provide the opportunity for children to experience junk modelling. Dinner Money

Just a reminder to those in the Full Time class that pay for dinners.

Dinners costs £12.50 per week (£2.50 per day).

If your child is absent you will get a refund the following week for the days missed.

Please do not pay for more than one week in advance as we do not have facilities at the school to store the money and we can not lodge the dinner money into the school meals account in advance.
